



KBA: How to Use Your C2C Lesson/Assessment - A Guide for Students

Hey there! Ready to learn how to use your C2C lesson? Let's go through it step-by-step.

Getting Started

1. Log in to your C2C account.
 - a. Click on the button in your Backpack, or
 - b. Go to the login screen that your teacher gave you.
2. Look for your lesson/assessment on the main page.
3. Click the "Start" button next to the lesson/assessment name.

Moving Through Your Lesson

1. Use the "Next" button at the bottom of the screen to go to the next slide.
2. Want to jump to a different part? Click "Go To" at the bottom and pick the slide you want.
3. For videos:
 - Press "Play" to watch.
 - Sometimes questions will pop up during the video - answer them when they appear!

Answering Questions

Multiple Choice Questions

- Read the question carefully.
- Click the circle or box next to the right answer(s).
- Hit "Submit Answer" when you're done.

Writing Your Own Answer

- Click where it says "Enter your text here."
- Type in your answer.
- Don't forget to click "Submit Answer" when you're finished!

Other Fun Question Types

- Some questions might ask you to drag things around or label pictures.
- Just follow the instructions on the screen - you've got this!



Cool Tools to Help You

Look at the top of the screen for helpful tools like:

- Highlighter (to mark important stuff)
- Calculator (for math problems)
- Notepad (to jot down notes)
- Dictionary (if you're not sure what a word means)

Click on the tool's picture to use it.

Checking Your Work

1. At the end, you'll see a page that shows all the question numbers.
2. Want to change an answer? Just click on that question to go back to it.
3. When you're done, click "Go To" and then "Review/End" to get back to the summary page.

Finishing Up

1. When you're all done, click the "Submit" button.
2. A box will pop up asking if you're sure - click "Yes" if you're ready to turn it in.

Tips for Success

1. Read all the instructions before you start answering.
2. If you're not sure about a question, use the "Mark for Review" button (if you have one) to come back to it later.
3. Use the helpful tools if you need them.
4. Double-check your answers before you submit.
